Instructions: How to access homework information on Emmlink

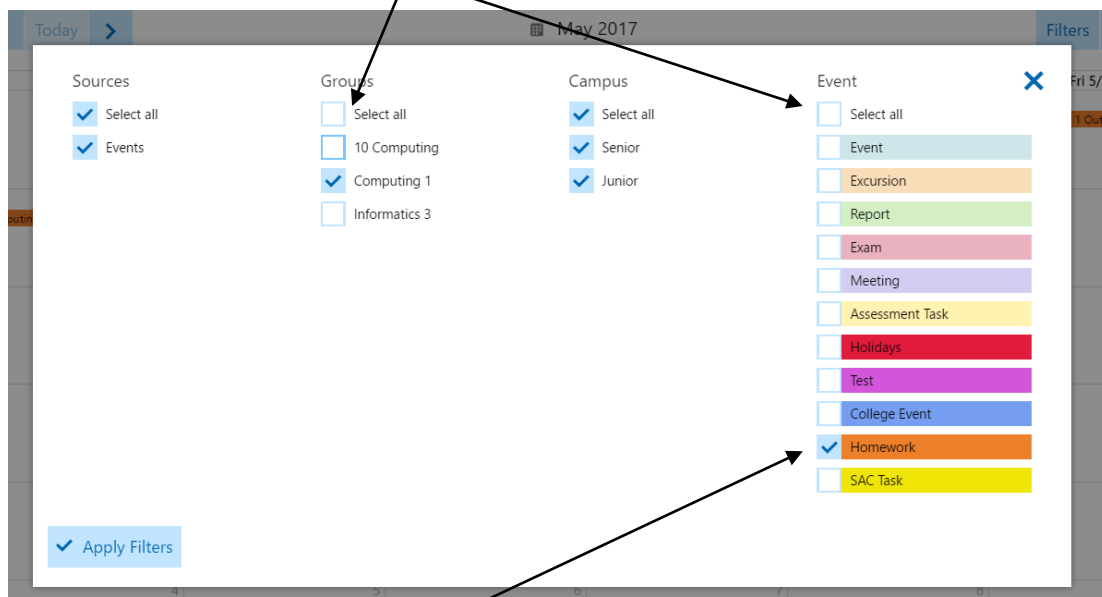
1. Log onto Emmlink at <https://emmlink.emmaus.vic.edu.au/login/> with your username & password provided by the College.
2. The following screen will appear;

4. The grades button will display all your son/daughter's results for assessment tasks.
In 2017, Year 11 students will receive their results through this platform.

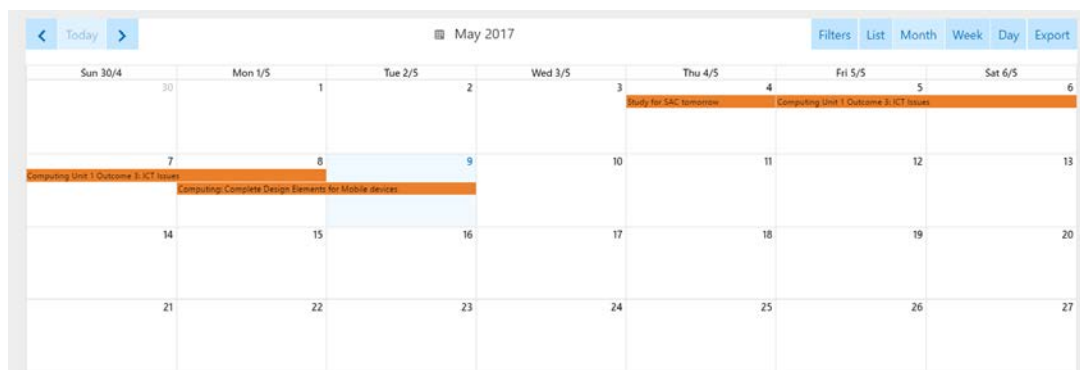
You are able to decide which types of events you wish to see.

Select all button unchecks all events and groups (classes).



Select the events you wish to see. For example, homework, then Apply Filters.

If you wish to see homework for one class/subject, you are able to select the classes under groups. Only the homework tasks will be visible.
