The Year 7 Camp to Rawson, Gippsland usually takes place in February each year. It is part of the orientation/transition program for our new Year 7 students. 
#### Central Australia

Language students have the opportunity to travel to our Sister Schools in **Italy** and **Indonesia** every two years, and to **Germany** every year.

The exchange trip to Italy begins with a week at our Sister School in Pinerolo, and continues with a tour visiting Venice, Florence, Pisa, Rome and Naples.

The trip to Indonesia starts with an exchange at our Sister School in Jakarta and ends in Bali. The students take part in many activities to enhance their knowledge of the country and its culture.

Year 10-11 students of German have the opportunity to travel to Germany at the end of every year to our Sister School in Ostbevern. The exchange program ranges from 3-8 weeks duration.
